- Hold a number of Ministry Area-wide social and fundraising events

Initiatives already underway

- Launch a monthly Open Table service to reach out to the LGBTQ+ community
- Run a monthly 8-session discussion group based on the the series "The Chosen"

Ideas to explore in the future

- Run a Youth Alpha course for young people
- Build on the ideas raised in the Radical Welcome course in Lent 2024
- Launch a 'servers club' or similar for young people interested in serving at the altar

- All churches to advertise each others' services and activities
- Work towards bronze Eco Church awards for all churches
- Hold a Ministry Area-wide Sunday raising awareness of and celebrating the environment

Initiatives already underway

- Launch a Ministry Area website
- Continue with school uniform exchange and in future years hold across all areas of the Ministry Area

Ideas to explore in the future

- Explore running an initiative in partnership with Christians Against Poverty
- Set up a Men's Shed a community space for men to connect, converse and create
- Establish a Forest Church initiative, a creative way of exploring God in creation
